Grandview Gold Hires Veteran Geologist as Vice President Exploration Toby Hughes, P.Geo Brings Over 27 Years Mineral Exploration Experience

Toronto, Ontario May 28, 2008 – Grandview Gold Inc. ("**Grandview**" or the "**Company**") (GVX:TSX, OTCBB:GVGDF) is very pleased to announce the appointment of Mr. Toby Hughes, P.Geo, P.Geo (NWT/Nunavut, Manitoba, Ontario) as Vice President Exploration.

"I am very happy to welcome my long-time colleague and respected geologist Toby Hughes back into the Company fold," says Grandview President and CEO Paul Sarjeant, P.Geo. "Toby was Grandview's Chief Geologist prior to my arrival 18 months ago before he left to explore consulting opportunities in China, and North and South America. His remarkable resume chronicles successful minerals exploration and discovery projects throughout the world with particular emphasis on and interest in Archean greenstone geology, including time spent in the Red Lake Gold Camp working as a consultant to Goldcorp Inc.

One of the first orders of business for Mr. Hughes will be to interpret the results of the 2007 and early 2008 Dixie Lake drill programs to more precisely define parameters for geologists returning to the project this field season. After visiting Dixie Lake and other Red Lake and Rice Lake Gold District properties he will join Grandview geologists in the field at the Pony Creek Project on Nevada's Carlin Trend.

"I have worked on many projects on several continents covering significant project evaluation & acquisition, to management roles. I've returned to Grandview because I really like the Company and our opportunities," says Toby Hughes. "I like our prospects for growth, and I share Paul Sarjeant's somewhat aggressive approach to exploration. We both like to remain focussed on relatively few high-potential prospects in proven or provable districts and stick with them. We have a remarkably capable team of geologists, some of whom are new to me, and I look forward to getting out in the field and sharing my experience with them."
